

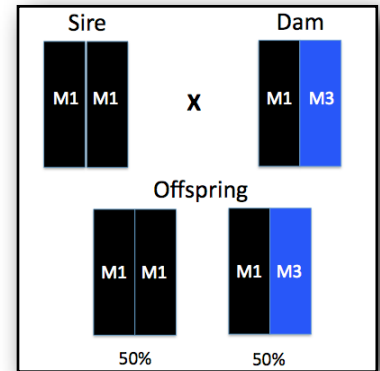
Unraveling Cyno DNA: Mapping a Path to Better Research Models
